

RAFFLE RULES AND REGULATIONS

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1. This raffle is conducted by the Francis M. Barrett Memorial Foundation (FMBMF), located at 1235 Bedford Street, Abington, MA 02351. FMBMF is a non-profit organization under Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3). All proceeds, less expenses, will be used to “Better the Lives of Others”.
2. The raffle will be conducted from October 2021 until March 31, 2022 (unless 2,000 tickets are sold before then). If this happens, we will inform everyone the date of the new drawing. The FMBMF reserves the right to sell a limited number of tickets on the day of the drawing if any are available.
3. A minimum of 1,500 a maximum of 2,000 tickets will be sold at \$100 per ticket. The odds of winning are dependent on the number of valid entries up to 2,000.
4. Purchasers of tickets must legibly write their name, address, phone number and email address (if applicable) on the ticket.
5. If more than one name is listed on the ticket, the first name listed shall be considered the “entrant.” The FMBMF shall, will and can have no obligation for delivery of any prize to any person other than the entrant.
6. Minors may not purchase or have their names identified as entrants.
7. Payment for the tickets shall be made in “good money” which may be cash, check, credit card, debit card. Checks should be made payable to “Francis M. Barrett Memorial Foundation.” If any purchaser’s check is dishonored by the bank, the raffle ticket will be declared invalid unless and until full payment in “good money” is made prior to the drawing. All purchases are final, and no refunds will be issued.
8. Winner will be picked by public random drawing to be held at 7:30 p.m. March 31, 2022, on Facebook Live (Facebook.com/AbingtonAleHouse).
9. Winner need not be present to win. Winner will be contacted immediately after the drawing.
10. Winner agrees to allow use of their name or likeness for publicity purposes without compensation.
11. Prize to be given away in the raffle is a 2021 Shelby GT500.
12. Winner must present the raffle ticket stub when claiming their prize, provide one form of picture identification and winner must complete and sign an IRS Form 5754, which requires a social security number or tax ID number. Delivery of the prize shall be made solely to the entrant based on providing the raffle ticket stub, picture identification, and, when required, a social security number/tax ID number and completion of a W-9.
13. Winner is subject to all Federal and State tax regulations and payment of any taxes is the sole

responsibility of each winner. The FMBMF will file reports pertaining to prizes that are more than \$600 and 300 times the amount paid for the winning ticket, to the applicable federal and state taxing authorities including, but not limited to, IRS Form W- 2G.

Winners acknowledge that the FMBMF, its Staff, Volunteers, Officers, its agents and representatives have not made and neither are they in any manner responsible or liable for any warranty, representation or guarantee expressed or implied in fact or in law, relative to any prize, including but not limited to its quality, mechanical condition or fitness for a particular use.
15. If the winner cannot be reached at the phone number, email address or mailing address on the ticket stub for any reason by April 30, 2022, a disqualification will result, and an alternate winner will be drawn.
16. A copy of all rules and eligibility requirements will be posted in the FMBMF entrance and on the web page.
17. The decision of the Executive Director and the Board of Directors of the FMBMF shall be final on all matters concerning the raffle.
